Communion Distribution

At Trinity, all are welcome to receive Holy Communion, both bread and wine. A gluten-free option is available for the bread; please let the pastor know if you need that option. There are 2 options for receiving wine after receiving and eating the bread:

- You may take a small cup and the communion assistant will pour wine in it from the pouring chalice, (small cups, once used, can be deposited in baskets by side windows),
- You may receive the words “the blood of Christ shed for you” without consuming the wine.

At the conclusion of the distribution, communion servers will offer bread and wine to those who may need to stay in their pew.

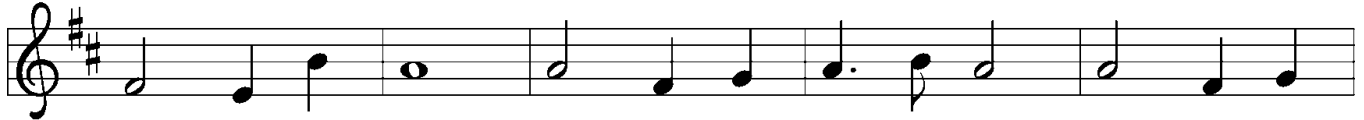

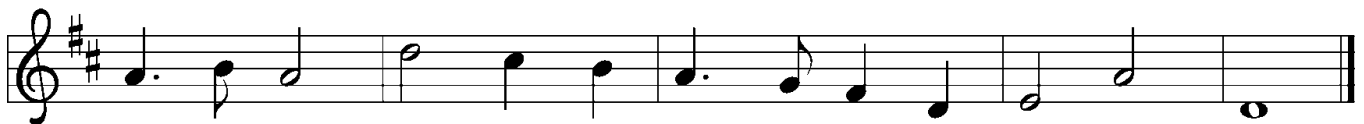

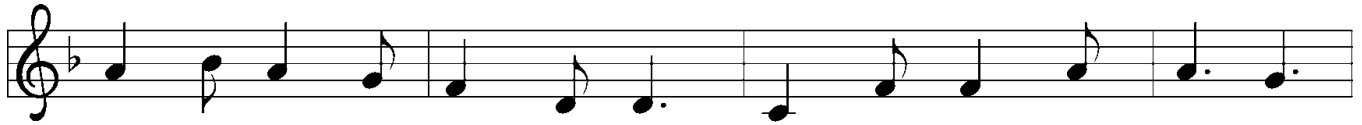
